

Interagency Council on Statistical Policy Mentoring Program

Background

The Interagency Council on Statistical Policy (ICSP) Mentoring Program was developed to facilitate interagency sharing of knowledge and skills, and to target mission-critical occupations. In 2014, the program was conceptualized at the spring retreat. ICSP hosted the first cohort in 2015. An average of eight agencies participate annually, with 4 new agencies participating in 2023. Each agency provided up to 2 mentees (GS 12/13) and mentors (GS 13/14 or higher) from each. The goals of the program are to:

- further professional growth and development of the participants, and to
- enhance connections across the Federal Statistical System

The program is open to analytical staff nation-wide (e.g., survey and mathematical statisticians, economists, demographers, data scientists, etc.) throughout the Federal Statistical System.

Program Events

The working group hosts events throughout the program to engage participants, while they also explore their mentoring program relationships. We hosted 12 events in 2023: ten virtual and two optional in person events.

- CliftonStrengths assessment and debrief
- Networking sessions (virtual and optional, in person)
- Leadership Panels
- Speed Mentoring
- Mentor-only and Mentee-only sessions
- Federal Committee on Statistical Methodology Research & Policy Conference (optional, in person)
